Acceptable MSc degrees for Ph.D Programs

Bachelor's degree in Urban and Regional Planning or Master's degree in Urban and Regional Planning, Urban Planning, Regional Planning, Urban Design, Traffic Planning and Implementation, Geographical Information Systems in Planning, Urban Policy Planning and Local Governments, Urbanisation and Environmental Problems, Urbanisation and Environmental Sciences **(A preparatory program is applied to graduates of other undergraduate programs except for graduates of Urban and Regional Planning. However, if the candidate has completed his/her master's degree in urban planning and received scientific preparatory education, he/she does not need to take the scientific preparatory**
