It was unanimously approved, as attached, the requirements submitted by the Graduate School of Health Sciences to be applicable to students enrolling in graduate programs beginning in the Spring Semester of the 2024–2025 Academic Year within the scope of obtaining the ORPHEUS Label (Organization for PhD Education in Biomedicine and Health Sciences in the European System) and Graduate Quality Processes.

Students Enrolled in the Graduate School of Health Sciences;

To graduate from a Master's Program (Thesis), students must fulfill **at least one** of the following requirements:

- Publish one article related to the thesis topic in a national/international* journal or have such an article accepted for publication.
- Deliver an oral presentation related to the thesis topic at an international congress/symposium*.
- Submit an application for a national or international patent or utility model related to the thesis research that has reached the examination stage.

***: Internationally recognized congresses/symposia approved by the University Executive Board.

Graduate School of Health Sciences

A. Faculty members to be appointed as advisors to students enrolled in ***Master's Programs (Thesis)*** must satisfy all of the following requirements:

A1. Complete the Advisor Training Program offered by the Graduate School of Health Sciences.

A2. Have taught or be currently teaching at least one graduate-level course (excluding Seminar, Thesis Preparation, and Thesis courses) within any graduate program offered by the Graduate School of Health Sciences during the most recent two academic semesters.

A3. Sign the Advisor Agreement within one month following the advisor appointment.

A4. Have published or received acceptance for publication of at least one research article within the last two years in journals indexed by Web of Science or in journals approved by the Senate of Gazi University.

B. No specific requirements are stipulated for faculty members appointed as advisors to students enrolled in ***Non-Thesis Master's Degree*** programs.

Graduate School of Health Sciences

Graduate School of Health Sciences (Requirements for the Establishment of a Doctoral Dissertation Defense Committee)

For students enrolled in doctoral programs within the scope of the ORPHEUS (Organization for PhD Education in Biomedicine and Health Sciences in the European System) Label, **at least one** of the requirements specified in Items 1, 2, or 3 must be fulfilled in order for a doctoral dissertation defense committee to be established.

1. One research article related to the student's dissertation, prepared jointly with the advisor, in which the student is the first author, published or accepted for publication in a Q1-indexed scientific journal.

2. At least one research article related to the student's dissertation, prepared jointly with the advisor, in which the student is the first author, published or accepted for publication in a Q2-indexed scientific journal, in addition to one research article submitted for review.****

3. The doctoral student is the first author of:

3.1. One dissertation-related article published or accepted for publication in a journal indexed in SCI-Expanded, SSCI, or AHCI.*****

3.2. One dissertation-related article published or accepted for publication in a journal indexed in the indices (*****) to be designated by the Graduate School Board for a two-year period.

3.3. One dissertation-related article submitted for review to a journal indexed in the indices to be designated by the Graduate School Board for a two-year period. (The evaluation of an article submitted for review shall be conducted by the Dissertation Monitoring Committee.)

**** With respect to the dissertation research, a national or international patent/utility model application that has reached the examination stage shall additionally be considered equivalent to one article published in a category other than Q1, provided that it is related to the dissertation.

***** TR Dizin shall be included as a mandatory index, and the remaining indices shall be determined and announced by the Graduate School Board.

Graduate School of Health Sciences

Faculty members to be appointed as **doctoral advisors** must satisfy all of the following requirements:

1. Have completed the Advisor Training Program offered by the Graduate School of Health Sciences.

2. Have taught or be currently teaching at least one graduate-level course (excluding Seminar, Thesis Preparation, and Thesis courses) within any graduate program offered by the Graduate School of Health Sciences during the most recent two academic years.
3. Have supervised and successfully completed at least one master's thesis (this requirement shall not apply to faculty members who are graduates of medicine, pharmacy, dentistry, or veterinary medicine programs with a minimum duration of ten semesters excluding the preparatory year, or who hold specialist qualifications in a laboratory discipline in accordance with the regulations issued by the Ministry of Health).
4. Sign the Advisor Agreement within one month following the advisor appointment.
5. Have published or received acceptance for publication of at least one research article within the last two years in journals indexed in SCI-Expanded, SSCI, AHCI, or ESCI; or have published at least one book or book chapter in their field of expertise; or have served or be serving as a coordinator, principal investigator, or researcher in completed, ongoing, or submitted TÜBİTAK projects or international research projects; or have submitted an application for a patent or utility model.
