

## **Basic First Aid Training**

Basic First Aid Training is a total of 16 hours, two days and 8 hours a day. After the training is completed, the exams are administered by the provincial health directorate. The exams consist of written and practical two stages, and those who score 85 and above are considered successful. Those who are successful in the exams are given a first aid card and certificate approved by the Ministry of Health.

**Application Requirement:** To be at least primary school graduate.

**Course fee:** 600+VAT= 708 TL determined by the Provincial Health Directorate commission in 2021 (including exam, certificate and identity card fees).
